This is a fun way for students to share their writing with their peers, whilst building on their confidence, and public speaking skills. We will be making some fun Easter craft and enjoying a whole class reward as the students have worked incredibly hard to reach 1000 dojos as a whole class, throughout the term.

For PDHPE I will be introducing students to the concept of being a bucket filler or bucket dipper, based off the story book 'Have you Filled a Bucket Today' by Carol McCloud. This is a wholesome and important activity for all ages, which will conclude our learning on positive and healthy relationships.

What have we been learning with Mrs Munro on Thursday and Friday?

Year 5/6 Geometry and Measurement

Over Term One the students have revisited different lines and angles; used different units of measurement (kilometres, metres, centimetres and millimetres) to estimate, measure and compare lengths and calculate perimeter; calculated areas using the formula Area - $l \times b=?$ sq. units of regular and irregular rectangles and measured one hectare within the school grounds and calculated the total area of the school land.

We are currently revisiting the properties and definitions of three-Dimensional objects. Students will be sketching, drawing, and construct simple 3D objects – prisms, pyramids, cones, spheres and cylinders.





K/1/2 Science & Creative and Expressive Arts

Creative and Expressive Arts tie in with the Science and Literacy activities.

Our unit of investigation for Term One has been 'The Earth and Space - Our Resourceful World'. Students have been exploring the different resources of our Earth: -water, air, rocks and soil, plants and animals and the sun.

Life cannot exist without these resources.

Students have investigated how humans use these resources, questioned if any of the resources will run out and how we can reduce, re-use and/or recycle these resources.


